Shopping center hearing is set

The El Dorado County Planning Commission will hold a hearing today on plans for the Green Valley Station shopping center, proposed on 12.9 acres in the Cameron Park area.

The plan calls for a 64,079-square-foot center, including two drive-up fast-food restaurants and a pharmacy with a drive-up window.

The property is on the southeast side of Green Valley Road, east of Cambridge Road.

The commission also will review the design for a 5,000-square-foot metal storage building, with parking area and landscaping, proposed on the southwest side of Highway 193, west of Weed Patch Court in the Greenwood area.

A discussion also is scheduled regarding setbacks for agricultural structures.

The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the Building C hearing room, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville.
